

CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF COURSES AT SUNCADIA

OVERVIEW

Suncadia offers three scenic championship golf courses on its 6,400 acre property. Set within a pine and fir forest with lakes and ponds, **Prospector Golf Course** is adjacent to the 18-room Inn at Suncadia. The private **Tumble Creek Golf Course** flows through forests, along the river bluff, and across expansive meadows creating an extraordinary golf experience. Family friendly **Rope Rider Golf Course**, which is currently under construction, is named after the coal miners who precariously balanced themselves on the coal cars that maneuvered the steep slopes of mine shafts. The foundations and portals of mines No. 9 and 10 remain on the course, along with Tipple Hill - a 120-foot hill of coal tailings.

PROSPECTOR GOLF COURSE

COURSE

- Prospector is a spectacular, challenging, yet very playable 7,112 yard course for all skill levels. It consists of challenging changes of elevation, panoramic mountain views, lakes and white sand bunkers. The 10th hole, Prospector's signature hole, offers views of the Cascades and Cle Elum River Valley from its tee boxes set more than 120 feet above the fairway. Par is 72.
- Prospector offers private instructions, junior golf, group instructions and golf schools. Golfers can select which program is right for them or let PGA Teaching Professional Brady Hatfield customize a lesson program.
- In 2006, *Golf Digest* recognized Prospector in their "America's Best New Courses" rankings, placing the course #7 in the Best New Public Course \$75 and over.
- Grass includes bent grass on the greens, blue and rye grasses on the fairways and in the rough, and fescue in the deep rough.
- Carts are available.

TUMBLE CREEK GOLF COURSE

COURSE

- Tumble Creek is 6928 yards and comparable to the courses in Scottsdale and the Coachella Valley. The vision was to create subtle, classic golf holes reminiscent of the parkland courses in the east. Par is set for 71. In *Golf Magazine's* 2005 issue of top 100 courses in the U.S. and around the world, Tom Doak's Barnbogle (Australia) and Cape Kidnappers (New Zealand) both entered the top fifty at 49 and 27 respectively. Of the top 50 in the world, only eight courses have been built since 1936. Tom Doak currently has three of the eight with Pacific Dunes ranked 13th. In 2006, *Golf Digest* recognized Prospector in their 'America's Best New Courses' rankings, placing the course #7 in the Best New Private Course. Tumble Creek has been named one of 'America's Top Golf Communities' by *Travel + Leisure Golf*.

- Rope Rider is a 7,203 yard family-friendly, 18-hole course ideal for families and young golfers. With 150 yard youth tees on every hole and distinct three and six-hole loops, Rope Rider lets guest play 18 holes, or just a few quick holes with the kids. Par is set for 72.
